Rule number 1: look up and appreciate the curves of its architecture, the inventiveness of its designers and the excellence of its gastronomy.

Rule number 2: lose yourself in the pleasure of strolling freely through the different districts of a magical city where there's a constant mix of classic attractions and multicultural encounters!

Trendy cafés, legendary techno clubs and fashionable shop windows will mark out your discovery of Brussels, between a Grand'Place so beautiful it takes your breath away, unusual museums and Art Nouveau walks. It goes without saying that these walks are best taken with a hot waffle in your hand and washed down with one of the country's 450 beers!

FASHION DESIGN SHOPPING

Designer clothes, comic strip, jewellery, CDs, vinyl records, furniture, beer, chocolate... in Brussels you'll find things you've never seen anywhere else!

For the last ten years or so, young fashion and accessory designers have been vying with each other for inventiveness: discover the colourful windows with their cheerful displays of clothes, hats and jewellery. They've come straight out of the active imagination of young talents who now choose Brussels to give free rein to their work on shapes and materials.

Fans of the style definitely shouldn't miss quartier **Dansaert**: today, this is the centre of Young Design. This is where you'll come across world-famous Belgian fashion designers: from Martin Margiela to Christophe Coppens, from Chine to Olivier Strelli, it's no more than a couple of steps! Fans of weird shapes and strange materials will enjoy themselves in one of the many little design shops that line the streets of this highly-prized district.

For the dreamers among you, head for boulevard de Waterloo and the Galeries Royales Saint - Hubert, which offer all the panache of haute couture and tailor-made design.

As for quartier **Saint-Boniface**, it will appeal to fans of the 9th art – and there's no shortage of them. In the temples of the speech bubble you'll unearth new or second-hand comic strip books, ex-libris bookplates or figurines. You'll be a short step from **chaussée d'Ixelles** and **avenue de la Toison d'Or**, mazes of shops and shopping arcades.

Rue Neuve, galerie Agora (next to the Grand'Place) and second-hand shops are also an interesting alternative if you're a bit strapped for cash... silver jewellery, CDs, DVDs or streetwear will definitely persuade you to part with a euro or two!

For souvenirs, you'll be spoiled for choice: 'pralines' (those heavenly individual Belgian chocolates), Kriek and Faro (traditional beers of Brussels), corkscrews in the form of Manneken-Pis, Brussels' lace and spéculoos (spicy biscuits) await you all around the Grand'Place and Manneken-Pis area.

THE CULTURAL ESSENTIALS

La Monnaie, royal temple of opera, **BOZAR**, a place where all the arts come together in the belly of an architectural jewel of Art Deco, and **Flagey**, that wonderful factory of sound and pictures, stand out as the most impressive of these centres of culture, not to mention the **Botanique** and the **KVS**. In the heart of the city, the many different café-theatres have an abundance of up-and-coming young talents.

MUSIC

There's a long list of performers from the region, whose reputation is already firmly established, and an equally long list of relevant events: the highly contemporary **Ars Musica** festival, the **Nuits Botanique**, the **Eu'ritmix** summer festival or the exotic **Couleur Café**. As for jazz, it's a real source of pride in Brussels, as the **Brussels Jazz Marathon** reminds us all every year. And we're just as proud of electro, drum 'n' bass and techno. The temples of those genres have been getting their fans up and moving wildly for more than twenty years.

DANCE

When it comes to dance, Brussels cherishes a long love story with its creative artists: Maurice Béjart of course, Anne-Thérèse De Keersmaeker, Frédéric Flamand, Wim Vandekeybus and Ultimavez, Michèle Noiret, Mossoux Bonté... There's many a festival that celebrates this wealth of creative energy, such as the **Bellone-Brigittines Festival** or the **KunstenFESTIVALdesArts**.

COMIC STRIP

Who hasn't daydreamed about the adventures of Tintin, that paper hero born here who contributed to the breathtaking development of the 9th Belgian art? Brussels, capital of Art Nouveau as well as of comic strip, also offers visitors the only discovery trail of its kind in the world, inviting them to roam



the historic centre from one colourful wall to another, walls depicting the heroes from our favourite albums. The **Belgian Centre for Comic Strip Art**, housed in the former Waucquez stores, a symbol of Art Nouveau, has an impressive collection of original printing plates and other objects that belonged to many comic strip artists. It offers a permanent "bédéthèque" (comic strip library) of almost 30,000 albums as well as numerous themed exhibitions. Not far from there, the **House of Comic Strip** celebrates the mythical Marcinelle School; you're bound to be familiar with many of its heroes: Gaston Lagaffe, Marsupilami, Lucky Luke, Spirou and many others.

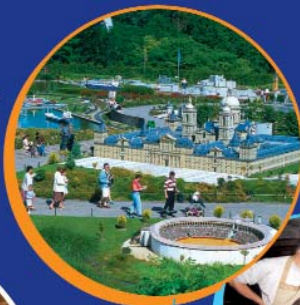

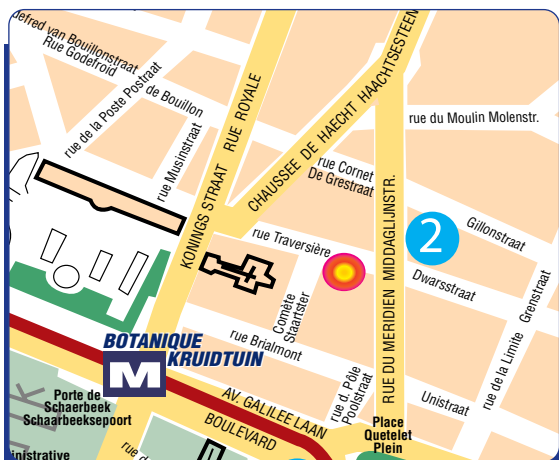
